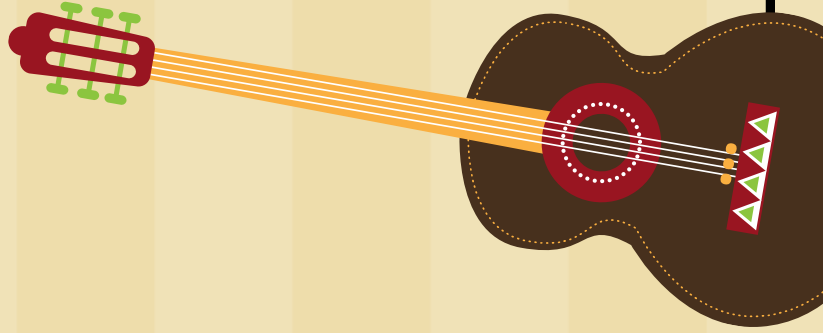

HOW TO TUNE YOUR GUITAR



STANDARD TUNING

Step 1:

Standard tuning has each guitar string tuned to notes E, A, D, G, B & E (order *from thickest to thinnest* string). The sixth string is the thickest string.

Step 2:

Grab a digital tuner (app, clip-on, or plug-in).

Step 3:

Tighten or loosen the tuning peg until the tuner displays the corresponding note: so when tuning the sixth string, the tuner should display an E note.

Step 4:

Most tuners has a bar/needle that indicates the accuracy of the pitch. The bar or needle should be right in the center.

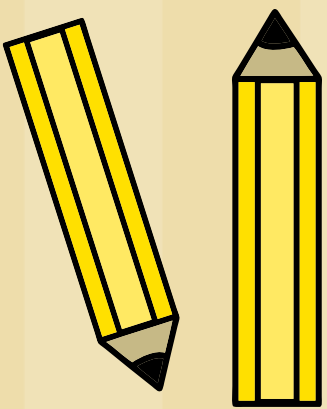
Step 5:

Repeat for the other 5 strings.



NO TUNER?

Lost your tuner or broke it? Try tuning your guitar by matching the pitches with your ear - watch this video to know how!



RIDDING THE 'TINK' SOUND

To fix it, **lubricate the grooves with a pencil lead** - the graphite acts as a lubricant!

If that doesn't work, take some **sandpaper and gently smooth** out the grooves.

STILL NOT IN TUNE?

If the above steps don't work out for you, take your instrument to a nearest guitar tech for a fix!
